JUSTICE AND PEACE - CALDERDALE LEARNING ACADEMY Liz Firth of the Justice and Peace commission wants to draw the parish's attention to the following local project. Our main programmes are about bringing children and young people together across difference to get to know each other and hopefully dispel any fears or misconceptions they might have. We are now delivering an increasing amount of Intergenerational Linking work where we bring together young people in secondary schools with local older people (anyone who is retired - we're not fussy on age). One school we'll be working with soon is Calderdale Learning Academy in Mytholmroyd so we're trying to find a group of local people who might enjoy coming into school on a few occasions to work with the young people on a social action issue they have identified - something they care about. The first session is booked for Thursday 16 March from 2-3pm in school and there'll be a few more sessions which are yet to be agreed.
