FR. LARKIN HAS BEEN APPOINTED TO FINANCE AND PROPERTY SUB-COMMITTEE for the Diocese of Leeds. Considering this new role, I will be attending regular meetings, including those scheduled for **Wednesday, 11 October**, **Wednesday, 15 November**, and a December meeting, to contribute to the strategic financial and property management decisions of our Diocese. Unfortunately, this means that the usual Wednesday 12 noon Mass will be cancelled on these specific dates. I ask for your understanding and support as I takes on this role to further the growth and development of our Diocesan community. The meetings usually commence at 12noon and end between 3pm and 3.30pm. All meeting take place at Hinsley Hall, Headingley Lane, Leeds.

A NEW ENGLISH LECTIONARY In England and Wales a new translation of the readings at Holy Mass will come into use from **Advent 2024**. This is based on the Catholic Edition of the English Standard Version Bible.

ANNUAL MASS COUNT A reminder that the annual count of Mass attendance should be made over the last two weekends of September (16/17 and 23/24) and the first two weekends of October (30 September/1 October and 7/8 October). This allows for parishes to avoid the weekends of the school half-term holiday.

BATLEY TORCHLIGHT PROCESSION Fr Hegarty and the Parish of St Mary's, Batley will once again be hosting the annual Batley Torchlight Procession. The Procession will take place on Monday 02 October 2023, commencing at 7:30pm. The Procession will again follow the new simplified route starting at St Mary's Catholic Primary School and ending at the nearby St Mary of the Angels' Catholic Church. The Torchlight Procession is a fine expression of our Catholic faith and gives honour to Mary, Mother of God. It is particularly valued by those who are unable to go on Pilgrimage to Our Lady's shrine in Lourdes. Refreshments will be served in the parish hall afterwards.

PRAYER FOR THE XVI ORDINARY GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS The XVI

General Assembly of the Synod of bishops will be opened by Pope Francis on 04 October and the Holy Father has asked for prayers of the whole Church to support the forthcoming Synod. As requested in my recent Pastoral Letter, I ask that parishes include the prayer, Adsumus Sancte Spiritus, following the Prayer after Communion and before the dismissal at the conclusion of weekday and Sunday Masses during the course of the Synod. Copies of the prayer card with the Adsumus will be sent to all parishes prior to 04 October. I hope too, that where the liturgical calendar permits, at least one weekday Mass will be celebrated in each parish during the period of the Synod using the proper texts from the Roman Missal pp.1310 to 1311, 'For a Synod' and Preface II of the Holy Spirit, pp. 1408-1409.

As the month of October is dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary, I invite you to consider offering a decade of the Rosary each week to pray for the maternal intercession of the Mother of God for the Church and the Synod. Please pray for our Holy Father Pope Francis, for me your bishop, and for all the bishops, religious and lay faithful taking part in the Synodal Assembly in Rome.
