SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY, 17 November 2024, churches from diverse backgrounds and traditions will unite again to emphasise the importance of safeguarding. Safeguarding Sunday offers a moment to reflect on our church's safeguarding journey, acknowledge past mistakes, and demonstrate a commitment to creating safer cultures for the future. Safeguarding Sunday allows churches to highlight and give thanks for the safeguarding work within their communities. It's a chance to remind everyone of the crucial role they play in creating safe, healthy environments.

SOCIAL MEDIA USE All content on a Parish social media site is ultimately the responsibility of the Parish Priest. If administrative rights are delegated to others, a protocol must be established. Both Parish and Clergy's personal sites must comply with legal standards, adhere to guidance like "Caring Safely for Others" and "Integrity in Ministry," and reflect the trust associated with ordained ministers and religious roles.

Key policies of the Diocese of Leeds include:

- Clergy's personal social media accounts must be moderated to remove inappropriate content and refer potential legal issues to the Safeguarding Team.

- Efforts must be made to prevent the viewing or sharing of inappropriate images on Church property.

- Any involvement with indecent images of children will be reported to the Police and the Safeguarding Team immediately.

- Photos of children can only be taken or shared with written consent from parents/carers.

- Safeguarding children's identities involves not using full names in photos and being aware of the "Jigsaw" effect, where separate pieces of information could unintentionally identify a child.

- Home addresses should not be posted online.

- Any indication of risk or harm mentioned on Parish social media must be reported to the Safeguarding Team. Immediate harm should be reported to the Police (999) and then to the Safeguarding Team. - Safeguarding is a collective responsibility.

THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER is associated with prayer for the Holy Souls. Masses will be offered throughout the year for those whose names are on the November Dead List. Envelopes are available for this purpose at the back of the church. Please PRINT the names of your deceased relatives and friends, in an envelope together with your offering. Once the list has been closed at the end of November, the offerings are made into £10-00 Mass intentions and celebrated throughout the year. This can be handed to Fr Larkin. A total of 43 Masses were offered for the deceased relatives and friends of the parish 2023/24. Return the envelop by **Sunday 24 November** thank you.
