HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL SERVICE HMD 2025 marks the 80th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi death camp of the Holocaust, during which 6 million Jews were murdered. This year will also mark the 30th anniversary of the genocide in Bosnia. HMD 2025 can be an opportunity for people to learn from and about the past and take actions to make a better future for all. On **Sunday 26 January** the eve of Holocaust Memorial Day there will be a special Service of Evensong at **Halifax Minster** starting at **4.00pm**. The guest speaker will be Rabbi Douglas Charing (visiting Rabbi of Bradford Synagogue. This year Holocaust Memorial Day commemorates the 80th Anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz concentration camp. All are welcome.
